Publicity: Letter to the Hon. Secretary from the
Hon. General Secretary, 17th October, 1955

"I have to draw your attention to Resolution D(3) of the 8th Conference which reads as follows:- D(3) 'That this Association continue and expand its policy of publicizing its activities through the press.'

This Resolution was considered by the General Council at its subsequent meeting and it was resolved as follows:- 44/55 'That Resolution D(3) of the 8th Conference be brought to the attention of all Branches and Sections and that they be urged to implement it through the press of all kinds including professional and trade publications.'

As you are probably aware, what the Conference and the Council had in mind was that the activities of the Association should be publicized through the press of all kinds including trade and professional journals by way of articles by members of the Association on its objects, organization, work and so on. This had already been done by various members in a variety of magazines and newspapers and it is desirable that it be continued as much as possible. I should be glad, therefore, if you would draw this to the attention of your officers and members and particularly to those who have special qualifications and abilities for this kind of work.
