All prices quoted are in Australian currency.

It is planned to issue towards the middle of 1970 a cyclostyled index to the first three volumes (November 1955-May 1969) of *Archives and Manuscripts*. This will be sold at 50¢ per copy, and requests for this index may be addressed to the Editor.
