

SYDNEY ARCHIVISTS' GROUP

Considerable interest was shown in the Group's programme in 1971, and four meetings were held. In March, Miss Patricia Kelly spoke on the problems of selection in a broadcasting archives; in June, Mr. R. Britton led a discussion on repair and preservation of records; in September, Mr. L. Newton Hobbs spoke on the A.B.C. oral history project and on recording technique and equipment; and in December, members of the Australian Jewish Historical Society spoke on Jewish records and history in Australia. A new Steering Committee of the Group was elected, comprising Miss P. Quinn (Bank of New South Wales), Mr. John Cross (Archives Office of N.S.W.), and Mr. G.L. Fischer (University of Sydney). The Group meets usually on the first or second Tuesday of March, June, September and December, and archivists visiting Sydney are warmly invited to attend the meetings.
