Articles should be presented on both disc and hard copy (double spaced, on one side of the paper only, leaving an adequate margin for instructions). Please contact the Editor to discuss disc format options.

A short abstract, approximately 100 words, should be included, together with a brief biographical note.

Articles longer than 5 000 words may need to be divided into parts and published in one or more issues.

Illustrations are welcome — good quality black and white prints are best for reproduction.

The *Macquarie Dictionary* and the Australian Government Publishing Service *Style Manual* are used for spelling and style, including endnotes. Bibliographic details should be given in full, without abbreviations.
