

Centenary Awards Fund

The Centenary Awards Fund, which has been established by Council, aims to finance awards for members of the Society to enable them to undertake advanced studies on aspects of the management of archives, or to work for a period in another archives institution to broaden perspectives and gain special expertise. This could be in Australia or overseas. The awards will be made by the Council in response to applications received and funds available. It is envisaged that the first awards will be made in 2001, the Centenary of Federation.

It is intended that sponsors outside the Society be invited to contribute to the Fund. However, before doing so, and as an indication of our commitment, funds are first being solicited from our own members.

I wrote to each member in April 1994 announcing the Fund and inviting contributions which are fully tax deductible.
